THE APPLICATION

The Otorohanga District Licensing Committee has before it an application by Nick Riley on behalf of Ngutunui Enviro School an *on-site* special licence pursusant to section 137 of the Act.

The event leading to this application are to be held at Puketotara-Ngutunui Hall, 400 Ngutunui Road, Otorohanga and can be summarised as follows:

To host a fundraising band and disco night for Ngutunui Enviro School. The event is planned for Friday 11 November 2016 from 7p.m. until midnight for no more than 95 people. The event is for over 18 year olds.

The event is not consider to be a large scale event in accordance with section 143 of the Act.

DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE

No objections have been filed in respect to this application pursuant to section 140 of the Act, and it is therefore determined on the papers by the Chairperson alone in accordance with section 191(2) of the Act.

Reports have been received from the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and a Licensing Inspector. No concerns have been raised in respect to the criteria outlined in section 142 of the Act.

There is no information to question the applicants suitability, and it is felt they have appropriate systems, staff and training in place to comply with the law. This, combined with the design of the

intended premises, and the availability of food, low and non-alcoholic beverages leads to the conclusion that there is unlikely to be any negative effect on the amenity and good order of the area, and that ultimately the application satisfies the object of the Act.

However, in order to ensure that is the case a number of conditions have been recommended in respect to the application. Namely:

- a) The event will be on Friday 11 November 2016 from 7 p.m. to 12 midnight.
- b) Alcohol sold/supplied to the following types of people: Those attending the function only.
- c) The fees payable for the licence concerned are: \$63.25
- d) Steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons.
- e) Steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises.
- f) Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business: on the table
- g) Food must be as follows: roast meat buns and chips or similar.
- h) Low alcohol beverages must be available as follows: low alcohol beer such as Light Ice.
- i) Non-alcohol beverages must be available as follows: tea, coffee, juice and soft drinks.
- j) Arrangements are to be made to ensure enough designated safe drivers are available for transport after the event.
- k) The appointed person shall be on duty at all times and shall be responsible for the management of alcohol sales. Their name shall be on display.

Having due regard to the application and the reports received, the application is hereby approved, subject to the above conditions. The special licence may be issued immediately, and shall remain in force until the conclusion of the final event as detailed in condition a) above.
