DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE

The Otorohanga District Licensing Committee has before it an application by *Satvir Singh* for the renewal of managers certificate number 018/CERT/012/16.

Reports have been received from the Police and a Licensing Inspector. No objections have been filed in respect to this application, and it is therefore determined on the papers by the Chairperson alone in accordance with section 191(2) of the Act.

No concerns have been raised in respect to the criteria outline in section 227 of the Act, in that reporting Agencies believe the applicant is a suitable person to continue to hold a managers certificate. The applicant has worked at Lavish since February 2016 and previously for 4 years at Denny's Restaurant and has not come to the attention of enforcement agencies in that time.

The applicant *has completed the bridging test to update his licence controllers qualification* However, Mr Singh's New Zealand work permit expires on 10 February 2017 and he has reapplied to Immigration New Zealand for an extension. His application is currently with them. Therefore the certificate can be issued for an extended period of*6 months*.....

However it is noted the numbering of the current certificate does not conform with the current numbering system required by the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority, so a replacement certificate should be issued.

Been satisfied as to the matters to which the Committee must have regard in s.227 of the Act the application is granted. The *replacement and renewal* certificate can be issued immediately.
