NOTES ON REGISTRATION

- All dog owners with dogs ordinarily kept in Otorohanga District must register with Otorohanga District Council.
- All dogs must be registered from 3 months of age.
- It is an offence to keep a dog older than 3 months unregistered. On conviction a Court may impose a fine up to \$3,000.00, or Council may issue an infringement notice with a fine of \$300.00 and/or a Animal Control Officer or Dog Ranger may seize and impound your unregistered dog.
- The application form for Registration must be complete and posted with the appropriate fees payable to: Otorohanga District Council, P O Box 11, Otorohanga 3900.
- When completing your Dog's details on the registration form, please record your dog's breed as accurately as possible. In the event of a mixed breed dog, please indicate the predominant breed first.
- Failure to supply any of the information requested in this form that is relevant to your application may prevent the registration of your dog. You are encouraged to request Otorohanga District Council to correct or amend any of these details if you discover a mistake or if the relevant circumstances have changed.
- Any dog registered for the first time on or after 1 July 2006 that is not classified as a working dog must be implanted with a Microchip transponder of the prescribed type and in the prescribed manner within 2 months of registration.
- It is an offence in making an application for the registration of a dog to make any written statement knowing that statement to be false. On conviction, a Court may impose a fine of up to \$3,000.00 or Council may issue an infringement notice with a fine of \$750.00.
- Replacement Tags may be obtained from the Otorohanga District Council if the current tag has been lost or stolen at no extra charge.
- Any dog not wearing a collar having a current registration tad or disc attached will, until the contrary is proved, be treated as unregistered.
- On change of ownership of any registered dog, both the previous owner and the new owner must, within 14 days, give written notice to Otorohanga District Council of the change of ownership and the residential address of the new owner and the address at which the dog will be kept. It is an offence not to comply with this requirement. On conviction, a court may impose a fine of up to \$500.00 or Council may issue an infringement notice with a fine of \$100.00.
- If the owner's address has changed within the district, the owner must within 14 days give written notice of the change to Otorohanga District Council. (*Change of Dog Registration Details form can be obtained from the Council Office or www.otodc.govt.nz*)
- If any dog is transferred to the district of another Council for one month or more, the owner must within 6 weeks of the transfer give written notice of the transfer to both Councils setting out the address at which the dog will be kept. It is an offence not to comply with this requirement. On conviction a Court may impose a fine of up to \$500.00 or Council may issue an infringement notice with a fine of \$100.00.
- Where the fee for the registration of a dog is paid and that dog dies, a refund for the remaining months of that registration year will be made upon receiving written request. (*Application for Refund of Dog Registration form can be obtained from the Council Office or www.otodc.govt.nz*) Please note, refunds can only be made from the date of request, and cannot be back-dated to the date of death.
- The registration fee includes G.S.T.
- Owners wishing to claim a reduced fee for de-sexed dogs must provide a veterinary surgeon's certificate certifying that the dog has been de-sexed.
- Your date of birth is required to enable you to be distinguished from other persons with the same name. Certainty of identification is required in the enforcement of the provisions of the Dog Control Act 1996.

RELEASE OF YOUR INFORMATION

The information provided on this registration form will be kept by the Otorohanga District Council but may only be used for lawful official purposes and will not be generally available for the public. However, Section 35 of the Dog Control Act 1996 allows the name and address of the owner of any specified dog to be made available to any person who had made a written application for that information. Before supplying the information, Otorohanga District Council must be satisfied of the identity of the applicant and that the information is required for one of a limited number of specified purposes, such as returning a lost dog to its owner or seeking compensation for damage.

CONTROL OF DOGS

Section 52, 53 and 54A, Dog Control Act 1996

The owner of any dog must keep that dog under control at all times and when in a public place, must use or carry a leash at all times (note Otorohanga District Council's Dog Control Bylaw 2005 requires all dogs in a public place to be leashed at all times unless in a designated dog exercise area).

A dog will be deemed to be not under control:

- If it is found at large on any land or premises other than a public place or a private way without consent (express or implied) of the occupier or person in charge of the land or those premises; or
- If it is found at large in any public place or in any private way in a contravention of any regulation or bylaw.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not of \$3,000.00 or an infringement fee of \$100.00 if you fail to comply with this provision.

OBLIGATIONS OF DOG OWNER ON OWNER'S PROPERTY

Section 52A Dog Control Act 1996

The owner of a dog must ensure, when the dog is on land or premises occupied by the owner,

- That the dog is under the direct control of a person; or
- That the dog is confined within the land or premises in such a way that it cannot freely leave the land or premises

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine \$3,000.00 or an infringement fee of \$200.00 if you fail to comply with this provision. In addition, Animal Control Officer or dog ranger may seize and impound the dog.

OBLIGATION OF DOG OWNER

Section 54 - Dog Control Act

The owner of any dog must:

- Ensure that the dog receives proper care and attention and is supplied with proper and sufficient food, water and shelter and
- Ensure that the dog receives adequate exercise.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to imprisonment for up to three months or to a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00 or an infringement fine of \$300.00 if you fail to comply with this provision.

MICROCHIPPING

Sections 52A and 65 Dog Control Act 1996

Microchip transponder must be implanted in dogs that:-

- Are classified as dangerous under Section 31 or classified as menacing under Section 33A or Section 33C on or after 1 December 2003
- Are registered for the first time on or after 1 July 2006 (Unless exempt under 36A Subsection 2A)
- Any dog impounded on a second occasion must be micro-chipped prior to dogs release
- Any unregistered dog that has been impounded must be micro-chipped prior to dogs release

The dog must be implanted with a functioning microchip transponder of the prescribed type in the prescribed manner.

For a dog that is classified as dangerous or menacing the dog must be made available to Otorohanga District Council Animal Control Officer for the verification that the dog has been implanted with a functioning microchip transponder of the prescribed type and in the prescribed location.

Dogs that are required to be microchipped will need to bring in a Microchipping Certificate with the name and breed of the dog to verify that your dog(s) have been microchipped.

If the microchipping requirement is not complied with, on conviction, a Court may impose a fine of up to \$3,000.00 if you fail to comply with this provision or Council may issue an infringement notice with a fine of \$ 300.00.

NATIONAL DOG DATABASE DOG COLOURS/BREEDS

From 1 July 2006 New Zealand dogs will begin to have their registration details stored on a New Zealand wide computer data-base, which has been designed by Internal Affairs. Every Council around New Zealand will be required to provide their district's dog information to the national data-base, starting on or around this date.

We need your help!

The national database will only accept specific dog breeds and colours, and therefore we need you to choose from the selection shown on the lists below and over the page.

If you cannot find a perfect match for your dog's breed or colour, please choose the closest possible option. The list has been put together by Internal Affairs with input from NZ Kennel Club, NZ Veterinary Assn, and some Councils, and is unlikely to be updated again any time soon, although requests for additions of established breeds may be considered.

What we need you to do ...

Check the attached lists to find the correct breed and colour for your dog(s). You must choose one predominant breed and, if your dog is a cross breed, a second breed also. You must also choose one predominant colour, plus a second colour (if applicable). For example, predominantly black with white and predominantly Collie with Poodle. If you have a mixed breed dog, just choose the breed your dog most closely resembles for the predominant breed, and choose "cross" for the second breed.

You cannot choose "cross" as the first predominant breed.

Clearly write this information against each of your dogs on the registration form.
