**Executive Summary**

There is a section of Merrin Avenue which does not have kerb and channel. This is incongruous with the rest of the Otorohanga Township. For this reason, a desire has been expressed by the local residents to bring this section of road to the same standard. The cost of this work is estimated at \$53,170.

**Staff Recommendation**

It is recommended:

That funds, estimated at \$53,170, from the Council funded roading sundry expenditure account (110 537 199) be consolidated over the next three-year period and allocated to installing kerb and channel to a 155m long section of Merrin Avenue, Otorohanga.

**Report Discussion**

The section of Merrin Avenue in question (as shown on the attached plan) which does not have kerb and channel is between sections of the road which do have. This estimate is to “fill the gap”. Currently there are no apparent stormwater issues as the majority of this section of road has a crossfall to the opposite kerb. (Water drains to the other side of the road.) There are however houses below the road level and in high rainfall events there is a possibility of the stormwater from the road running down the driveways of these properties. There is no allowance for stormwater pipes and catchpits in this estimate as the current water collected by the new kerb and channel would be captured by existing catchpits in the existing kerb and channel at either end.
